OUR HISTORY

In 1998, the number of independent compounding pharmacists taking a special interest in veterinary pharmacy led to the creation of the American College of Veterinary Pharmacists. The College is dedicated to helping veterinarians provide high quality therapies and services for their animal patients.

ACVP focuses on veterinary pharmacy issues including patient care, practice standards, and the continued veterinary/pharmacist relationship.

Membership in the American College of Veterinary Pharmacists is open to Veterinarians, Pharmacy Technicians, Pharmacy Marketers, Pharmacy Students, Affiliates, and Corporations who support the College's goals.

PHARMACY EDUCATION

American College of Veterinary Pharmacists supports the pharmacy profession through

continuing education sessions, live and on-demand webinars, specialty conferences, and publications. ACVP Fellows and members receive discounts on educational opportunities, including compounding training courses provided by ACA.



COMPOUNDING TRAINING COURSES

Compounding training courses are scheduled throughout the year at the ACA National Training Laboratory in Bartlett, Tennessee, which features fully-functioning standard and sterile labs. These courses are provided by and accredited by ACA. All training courses were revised to reflect the latest developments in compounding.

VETERINARY COMPOUNDING ESSENTIALS

The goal of this application-based course is to introduce the pharmacist and pharmacy technician to veterinary pharmacy compounding. The program provides fundamental techniques for effectively growing a veterinary compounding practice, including

calculations, proper safety practices, hands-on compounding, and marketing.

Class participants learn best-in-practice techniques through hands-on learning and unbiased presentations featuring multiple product lines and equipment. ACA courses feature small class sizes and highly-qualified instructors.

CONFERENCES

Each year, ACVP conducts the Veterinary Pharmacy Conference which combines continuing education credit with networking and fellowship. Recent educational topics include veterinary marketing, veterinary dosage forms and drug administration, drug and compounding legislation updates, and compounding for the equine patient.

Continuing education accreditation for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians is provided through ACPE. The accrediting organization is the American College of Apothecaries.
