2024 proposed bylaws amendment

The APhA Board of Trustees has proposed multiple changes to the APhA Bylaws, which require a 2/3 majority vote of eligible voters to approve.

Why are changes being proposed?

 Allows APhA to adapt to the needs of our members, who have expressed a desire to connect with APhA more easily. The change is needed to make the membership structure less hierarchical and increase opportunities for collaboration among all members.

Changes would:

- Allow for all APhA members to collaborate across all communities and reduce siloing of members into one specific area.
- Allow for representation of all membership classes (Pharmacist, New Practitioner Pharmacist, Student Pharmacist, Pharmacy Technician, and Pharmacy Researcher) on the APhA Board of Trustees. Every member will be able to vote in Board of Trustees' elections.
- Allow for flexibility within the APhA election process to adapt to current and future needs of the Association.
